Setting

- Nailed to the cross at 9:00 in the morning and by approximately 3:00 in the afternoon, Jesus had died.
- The first 3 hours, Jesus made three statements to people.
- The last 3 hours, Jesus made 4 statements to the Father.
- At noon, the earth became dark – "_____"
- During the afternoon...Jesus _____ "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani"
- Forsaken = deserted, rejected, abandoned

The Lord is not slow in keeping His promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

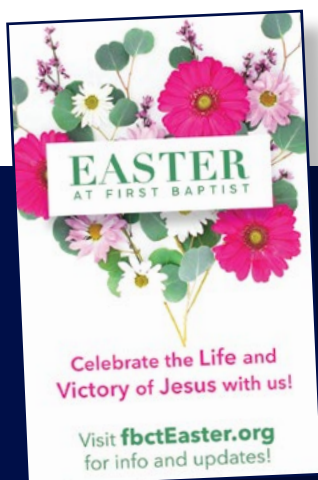
