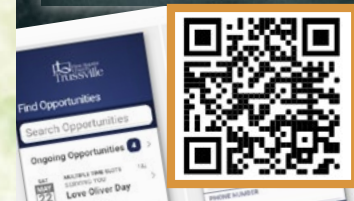
Fort Deposit Medical Clinic Trip
