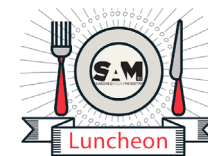
Come for a morning of fun and playtime with other preschoolers, moms, and grandparents, just like you!

We'll welcome special musical guests, *Doors of the Heart* for a time of singing and worship, followed by a delicious lunch!



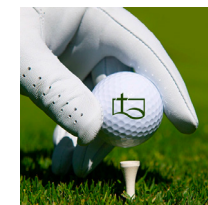
FBCT Golf Tournament
