WMU at FBCT is made up of a beautiful group of missionminded and mission-hearted women. At WMU we serve God by serving others. We love others by reaching out. We strive to spread 'Jesus' love' all around. This is done within our local community, throughout the surrounding area, and in far-reaching areas. This is accomplished through the many missions and ministries we are constantly involved with. They say it takes a village, and in WMU that's what we are. We are a beautiful village working together to love others as we strive to meet their needs and share the love of Jesus. As this love and the gospel are shared, people see Jesus. And that is what we're here for, to show Jesus to the world! A few of my favorite projects are The Mississippi River Christmas Backpack Ministry: This is a ministry in which we fill backpacks for children ages two through 17. These backpacks are given out at Christmas. They are filled with clothing, food, hygiene items, a Bible or devotional, and a Christmas toy. For some children, this is the only Christmas gift they receive. As the backpacks are given out the Christmas story is shared. These backpacks are sent to states on the Mississippi River Delta, which are some of the poorest areas in our country.

Cold weather packs for the homeless: Through this ministry, we get to help the homeless during some of our coldest temperatures of the year. Some are homeless due to hard circumstances and poor life choices. Others are homeless due to mental illness. Whatever the reason, we want to reach out and spread the love of Jesus throughout the community and do what we can to help keep them warm. We just want to be the hands and feet of Jesus as we serve God by reaching out to and loving others.



# Hear from a Local Partner

The Lovelady Center is a Christ-centered 9–12 month residential program for displaced women and their children. Their displacement comes from homelessness, domestic violence, substance abuse, and incarceration. Our 250,000-square-foot building is a home, a church, a school and so much more to over 450 women and 100 children. Our program is based on a holistic approach to addressing the mind, body, and spirit needs. This is done through counseling, discipleship, life-skill classes, health/fitness programs, continuing education, and job readiness. We hope all our women will build a strong foundation in Christ and become the women God created them to be. Over our 20 years we have served more than 15,000 women and countless lives have been impacted and forever changed. We are frequently asked how we do what we do. Our only answer is through the love of Jesus. That love is shown throughout our program in many ways, especially through our church partners and volunteers, like you. Thank you, First Baptist Church Trussville for partnering with us and making a difference in so many lives.
