#### 1. Scripture Reveals \_\_\_\_\_

<sup>13</sup> That very day two of them were going to a village named Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, <sup>14</sup> and they were talking with each other about all these things that had happened. <sup>15</sup> While they were talking and discussing together, Jesus Himself drew near and went with them. <sup>16</sup> But their eyes were kept from recognizing Him. <sup>17</sup> And He said to them, "What is this conversation that you are holding with each other as you walk?" And they stood still, looking sad. <sup>18</sup> Then one of them, named Cleopas, answered Him, "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?" <sup>19</sup> And He said to them, "What things?" And they said to Him, "Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, a man who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, <sup>20</sup> and how our chief priests and rulers delivered Him up to be condemned to death, and crucified Him. <sup>21</sup> But we had hoped that He was the one to redeem Israel. Yes, and besides all this, it is now the third day since these things happened. <sup>22</sup> Moreover, some women of our company amazed us. They were at the tomb early in the

morning, <sup>23</sup> and when they did not find His body, they came back saying that they had even seen a vision of angels, who said that He was alive. <sup>24</sup> Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said, but Him they did not see." <sup>25</sup> And He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! <sup>26</sup> Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into His glory?" <sup>27</sup> And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, He interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself."
